Cover Artwork (also used inside): \$400 plus 6 free calendars

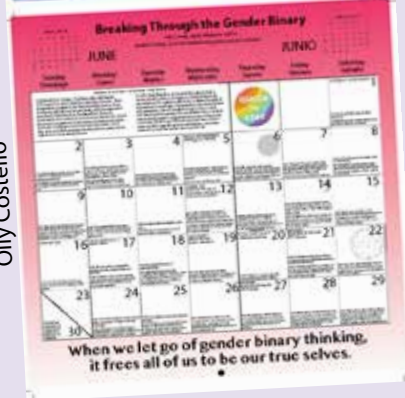
Commissioned Artwork: \$300 plus 5 calendars, Inside Artwork: \$250 plus 3 calendars
